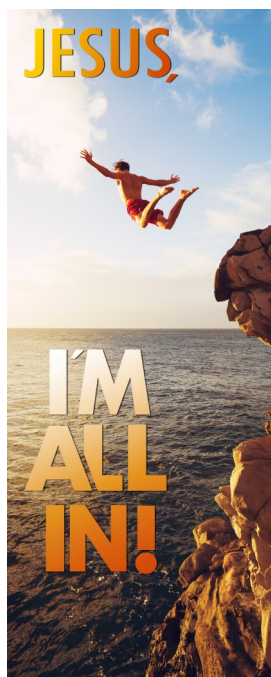


## Mission Idaho Update

Tuesday through Friday, U-PICK berries are available!

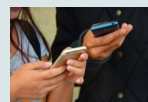
Bring your own containers. The berry patch is located just north of the Student Residence (the main dorm). These are no-spray berries.

Come explore how God is working through these ministries and find ways that you can minister, too!

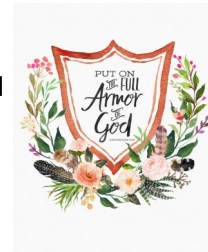
## IN CASE YOU CAN'T BE THERE . . .

Stop by the back of the Main Auditorium to see what the students of several of our Adventist Christian elementary schools have accomplished over the past school year.



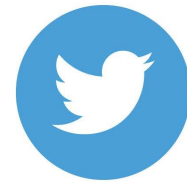

## PRAYER MINISTRIES

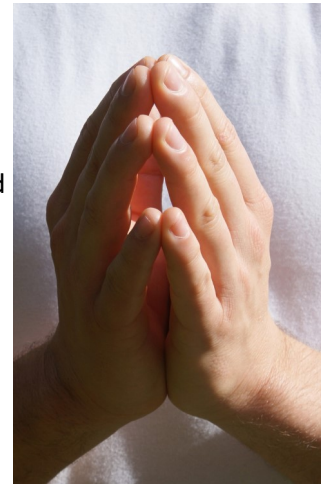
Is God calling you to a ministry of prayer? If you believe He is—the Idaho Conference needs you!
